Discover the Child's Wishes

A child's room should not only look beautiful but, above all, suit the child living in it. That is why the planning process begins with an open conversation. Ask your child what they wish for, which colors they like, and what activities they enjoy most. Perhaps they dream of a cozy reading nook, a large play area, a space for painting, or a bed that feels like a little cave.

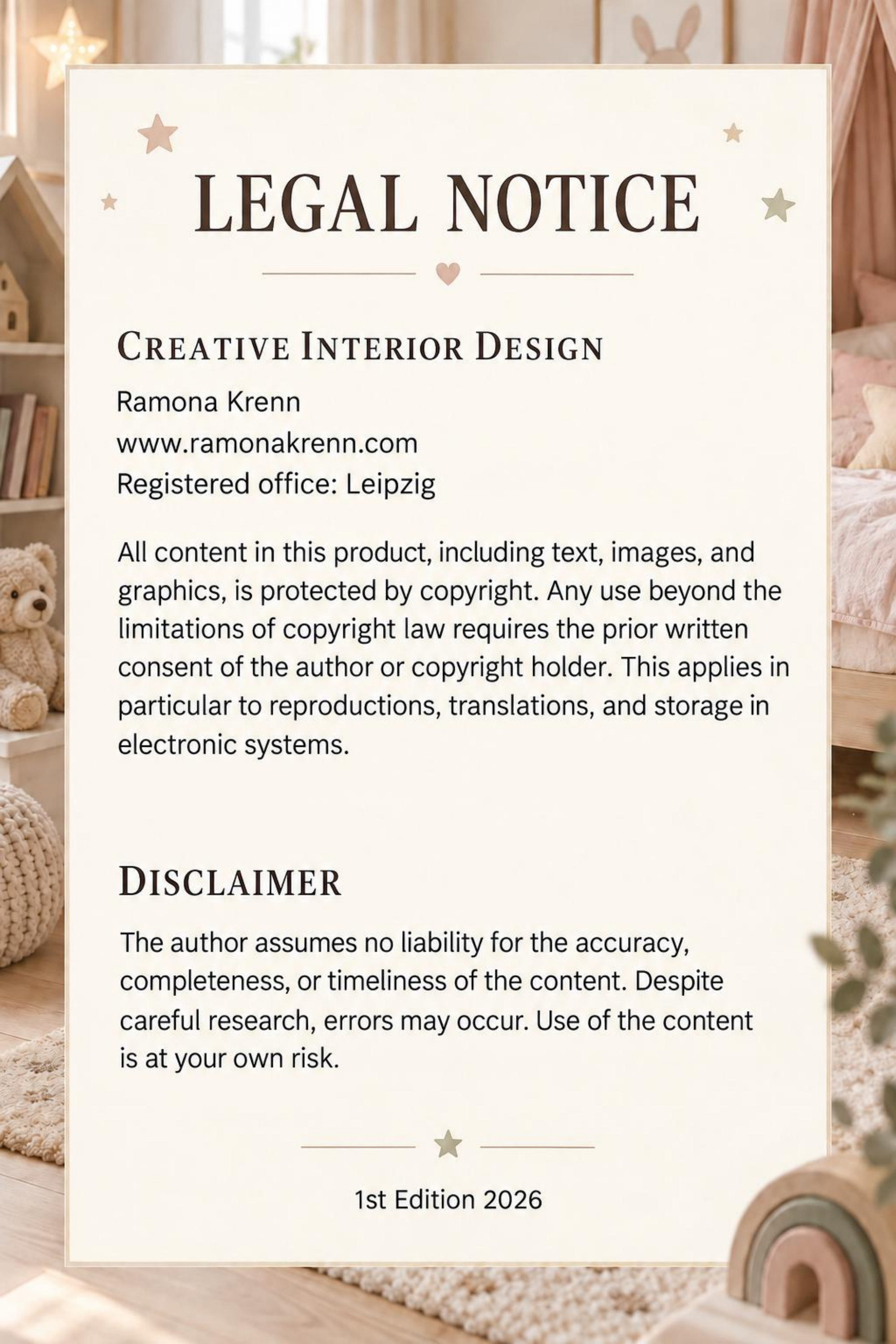
Depending on their age, your child might be able to clearly articulate their ideas or show them using pictures. Gather inspiration together from magazines, books, or image collections. Let the child choose colors, furniture, and decorations that appeal to them. You don't have to incorporate every single wish; the key is to identify recurring preferences and the personal sentiment behind the ideas.

Also, observe your child's daily routine: Do they like playing on the floor? Do they often build elaborate imaginary worlds? Do they prefer reading in seclusion, or do they need a quiet place to study? Such habits often reveal more about their actual needs than specific requests for furnishings.

Afterward, create a short wish list with three categories: "especially important," "would be nice," and "can be added later." This allows you to balance cherished wishes and functional requirements with your available budget.

Involving your child in the planning process creates a space they can truly identify with. They feel taken seriously and develop a stronger connection to their own personal domain. In this way, a simply furnished room transforms into a child's dream space—a place for playing, learning, exploring, and feeling at home.
